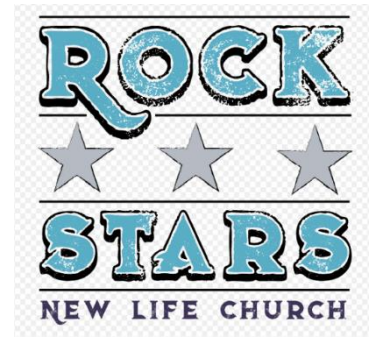


Hello, awesome Rock Stars!
