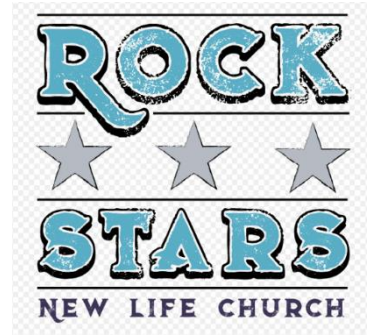


Hello again!
